He binds up your wounds with the healing balm of His Gospel, and He brings you into His Church, where He takes care of you at His own expense (Luke 10:34–35). By such mercy, He proves *"to be a neighbor to the man who fell among the robbers"* (Luke 10:36). Therefore, *"you go, and do likewise"* (Luke 10:37). By *"your faith in Christ Jesus"* and *"because of the hope laid up for you in heaven"* (Col. 1:4–5), you have the same love for others as the Lord Jesus has for you.

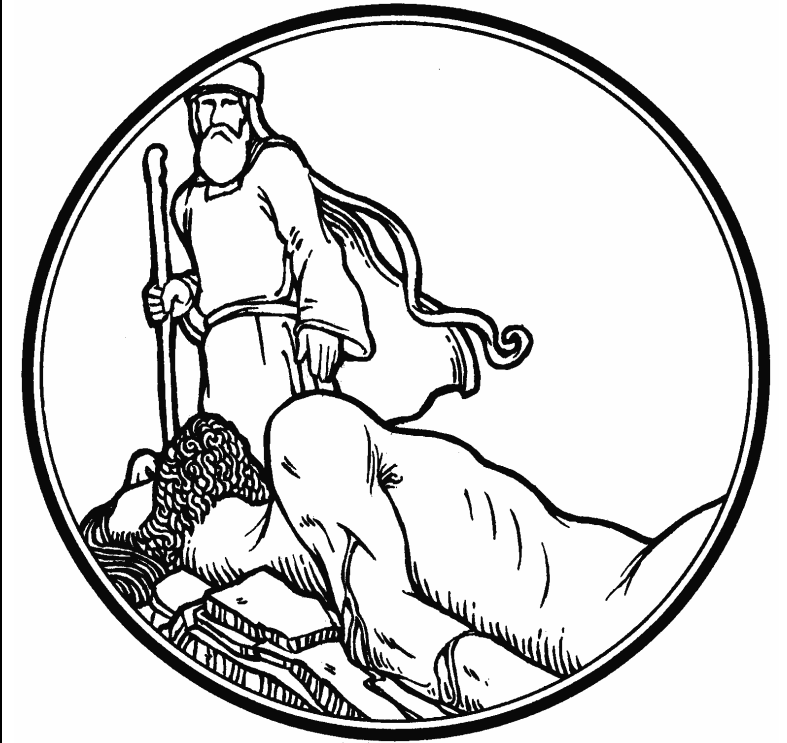
