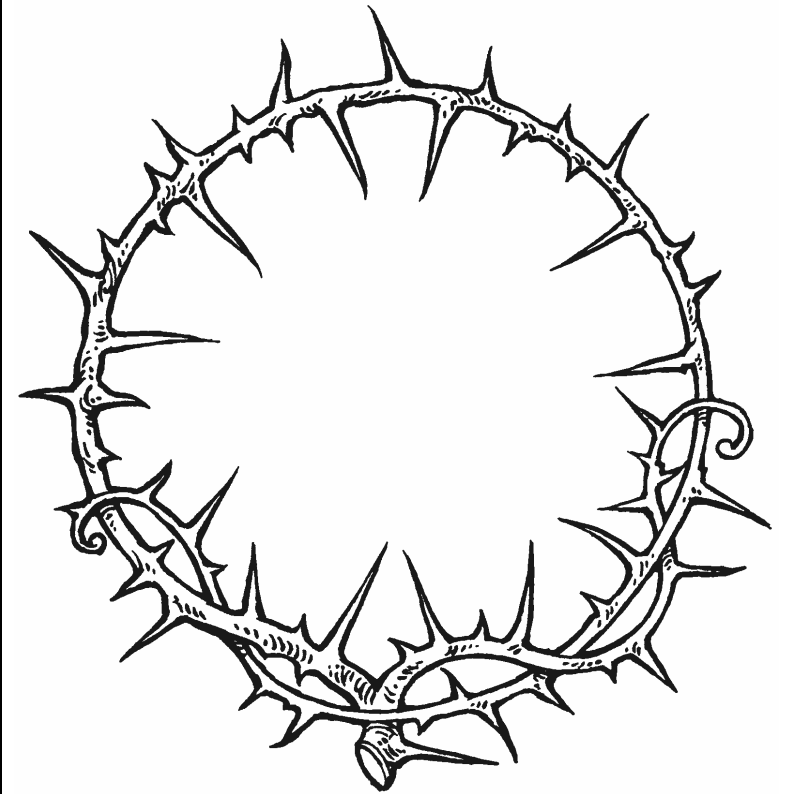
125th ANNIVERSARY PLANNING COMMITTEE: Thank you to everyone that donated to the bake sale.
