Brothers and Sisters in Christ:

As we enter summer, children everywhere are looking forward to summer break. Perhaps they've made plans with friends. Maybe you're looking forward to summer too, planning a vacation getaway or looking forward to a decrease in your usual work load.

Summer is often seen as a time to take a break. And in fact, in a very familiar passage of Scripture, the writer of Ecclesiastes says something similar

"For everything there is a season, and a time for every matter under heaven" - Eccl. 3:1

After stating this God gives many examples of different "times" one might encounter in life. And a time to rest is one of those. But in the midst of all these times, there is one thing that remains constant: our need for God's Word.

In speaking of God's commands, Moses tells the people the people:

"You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise." - Deut. 6:7

Anytime is a good time to be in the Word of God. When we are getting ready to rest or when we are done resting. When we are working or when we are sitting. When we are traveling or when we are stationary.

With this in mind we do not "take a break" from His Word. We continue in it. We gather for worship on a weekly basis so that we can be in the Word. We include opportunities for study like Vacation Bible School, so that even when school is not in session, and kids are not meeting for catechism class or Sunday school, they can still stay in the Word of God.

And we as adults are no different, we need to remain in the Word of God just as much. And so we continue with Bible Studies. We persevere in our devotional time, all because we recognize the importance of being in God's Word. God's Word has power. The writer of Hebrews talks about it in this way:

"For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart." - Heb. 4:12

God's Word is living and active it is constantly at work in the hearts of His people. Isaiah shares this confidence about God's Word and its effectiveness in chapter 55 where he states:

"so shall my word be that goes out from my mouth; it shall not return to me empty, but it shall accomplish that which I purpose, and shall succeed in the thing for which I sent it. "
- Is. 55:11

God's Word cannot return empty. It must accomplish the purpose for which He sent it. Knowing this, it makes it all the more essential that we continue our study of Scripture, so that the Word of God can do the thing He purposes for it.

And so today, I encourage you to look to the opportunities you have been given to be a part of the study and spread of God's Word. There are summer camps your kids can attend at Camp Okoboji, ways you can help out with our Vacation Bible School this summer (starting July 14), and Bible Studies you can attend, both Sunday mornings at 9 and Wednesdays at 11.

But the opportunities don't stop there. Even if you're traveling, visiting family this summer or taking the opportunity of the break to go on a much needed vacation. These typically happen over the weekend which means you're not able to be here with us in worship. But there are plenty of other opportunities for you to worship where you are. I encourage you as part of your vacation planning to take a look at <a href="www.lcms.org">www.lcms.org</a> In the top right corner of their website is a church locator that the LCMS has put together, so you can continue to gather in worship no matter where you are.

So, wherever you go, however you decide to break or vacation or relax this summer, remember the words of Deuteronomy, study God's Word that it might permeate your life.




